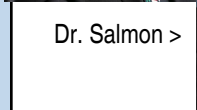

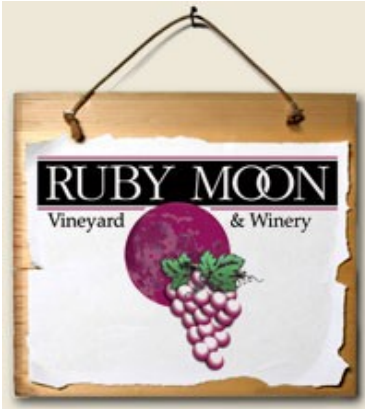

- [The Downtown Henderson Project](#) was started in 1986 with the help of the National and Kentucky Main Street Programs. The mission is to promote, improve, and preserve the unique character and economic vitality of Downtown Henderson.

[The W.C. Handy Blues & Barbecue Festival](#) began in 1991 and has become one of the largest free music festivals in the nation, drawing over 30,000 attendants from almost every state and many countries. The festival was recently recognized by the Kentucky Main Street Program as the number one outdoor festival in Kentucky and was voted "One of the Top Ten Festivals" in the Commonwealth by the Kentucky Tourist Commission, as well as being recognized as a "Top 20 Event" by the Southeast Tourism Society in 2009. The event is a celebration of the life and legacy of Henderson resident and "Father of the Blues," William Christopher Handy.
